

Young Investigator Award 2018

Guidelines:

During the Young Investigator Award session of the 21st Practicum on Clinical Exercise Testing, three prizes will be awarded to outstanding research projects. Scientific abstracts from the field of clinical exercise testing may be submitted by researchers of age 36 and less. Work in progress may be submitted as well as published projects, however the work must have been published in 2017 or later. Earlier publications will not be considered.

From all submitted abstracts, a jury of faculty members will select the best five abstracts for presentation in the main auditorium on Friday, October 19th. For all invited abstract presenters, the course fee will be waived. After presentation of all five abstracts, the best three projects will be selected by the faculty based on originality of the work, scientific quality and quality of presentation. The presenter of the best abstract will be awarded \$1000, the presenters of the other two abstracts will be awarded \$500.
